Enclosed in the two priority mail boxes with delivery confirmation numbers 0003 6739 5056 and 0001 1896 2223 to your attention sent this date are 1,825 pages of discovery documents being those consumers who filled out Plaintiff's questionnaire regarding adverse effects of Ambien. Most have attached medical records and other documents. The complaints range from, among other things, sleep eating and gaining excessive weight with diabetes or GERD, sleep driving and ending up in jail, having sex with partners without any memory and breaking bones from a fall while sleepwalking, all done after taking Ambien.

Not only are the enclosed pertinent to the class action and part of discovery that must be disclosed, but I understand your client has a duty to review them and make contact with each of the complainants by sending an adverse event/MedWatch form. I understand your client must insure an adverse event report is made regarding Ambien for each person, as well as any other post marketing obligations your clients have to the consumers. I am copying other parties to this letter because of their interest in insuring your client contacts the complaining consumers and follows the proper adverse event/Medwatch and post marketing procedures, as well as your client's US Pharmacovigilance department which contacted me regarding this issue.
